

Prime Area: Personal, Social and Emotional development

The children will:

Discuss in groups their families and who they live with at home.

Learn how to play in a group, taking turns and listening to each others ideas.

Understand their own feelings, and learn that some actions and words can hurt others' feelings.

Become confident to select and use activities and resources without help from an adult.



Prime Area: Physical Development

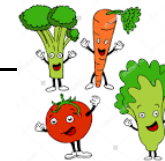
The children will:

Make various healthy food, learning why they are healthy and knowing the foods that we can have as a special treat.

Learn how to move their body in different ways. Running, walking and jumping to name a few.

Draw lines and circles using gross motor movements.

Use one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. makes snips in paper with child scissors.



Specific Area: Mathematics

The children will:

Recite numbers in order to 10

Learn that not only objects, but anything can be counted, including steps, claps or jumps.

Recognises numerals 1 to 5.

Count up to three or four objects by saying one number name for each item.

Go on shape hunts around the school to search for 2D and 3D shapes.



All About Me

Prime Area: Communication and Language

The children will:

Retell simple stories using small world resources.

Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.

Understand prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind' in different contexts.

Compare themselves to characters in books.

This is an overview of the 7 areas of the EYFS Profile. It shows the learning in the different areas that will take place this half term. The activities to promote the children's learning will be planned for each week with the children's ideas and interests being used.



Specific Area: Literacy

The children will:

Learn to recognise their name.

Learn to write their name.

Listen to fiction and non fiction books.

Retell stories they have read through role play.

Learn a new rhyme each week.

Draw pictures of themselves and family members.

Visit the library to choose books.

Specific Area: Understanding the World

The children will:

Speak about their home life and who they live with.

Learn the Christmas story and how people celebrate Christmas.

Learn the days of the week.

Learn to describe the weather and how we need different clothing.



Specific Area: Expressive Arts and Design

The children will:

Learn different nursery rhymes and songs.

Use their bodies to learn and create their own dances.

Create different objects using blocks inside and outside.

Use different small world toys to create their own narratives.

Describe the textures of different objects and materials.
